Loriga is an ancient, beautiful and historic small **Portuguese** town, located in the **Serra da Estrela** mountains. Known as *Lobriga* by the **Lusitanians** and **Lorica** by the Romans, it is more than 2,600 years old. Notable people from **Loriga** include **Viriathus** (known as *Viriato* in **Portuguese** and castilian), a famous **Lusitanian** leader and **Portuguese** national hero.
